- THEA 201: Technical Theatre Practice
 - o In the Technical Theatre Practice course, I taught the lighting segment, equipping students with foundational skills in entertainment electrics through hands-on work with lighting instruments and safety protocols. By the end, they demonstrated practical expertise in safe fixture handling, power distribution, and essential lighting operations for live performance.
- THEA 120: Principles of Design for Theatre and Film
 - I redesigned the Principles and Elements of Design course to emphasize hands-on, project-based learning that deepened students' understanding of visual storytelling in theatre. Through experiential exercises, they explored core design principles and elements, building a strong foundation for advanced creative work.
- THEA 112G: Intro to Theatre
 - Intro to Theatre blends academic study with experiential learning, guiding students through theatre history and collaborative roles like acting, directing, and design. The course culminates in a group production project, deepening their understanding of theatre's cultural impact and creative process.

Co-Instructor

- THEA 430/830: Master Electrician
 - The Master Electrician course trained students to lead electrics crews and manage production paperwork with technical fluency. As co-instructor, I emphasized networking, cable types, and troubleshooting, preparing them for professional roles in entertainment systems.
- THEA 398/898: Vectorworks and Visualization
 - o The Vectorworks and Visualization course taught students to draft light plots and simulate design choices using platforms like ETC Augment3d and Capture. I led the pre-visualization portion, guiding them in cue creation and system integration to enhance rehearsal readiness and design communication.
- THEA 409/809: Advanced Lighting Technology
 - O Advanced Lighting Technology trained students in programming lighting consoles for theatre and live performance, emphasizing both designer collaboration and busking techniques. I taught the ETC Eos portion, guiding students through navigation, cueing, and workflows for scripted and spontaneous lighting scenarios.

• THEA 1013: Survey of Theatre

 The asynchronous Survey of Theatre course guided students through theatre history, acting, and design using curated videos and readings. Through critiques and presentations, they developed a foundational understanding of theatrical storytelling and technical elements.

 The Theatre Improvisation course used games, exercises, and a terminology quiz to build students' spontaneity, confidence, and public speaking skills. By the end, they demonstrated improved communication, adaptability, and stage presence in a supportive classroom environment.

 The Production Practicum course offered students hands-on training in lighting and sound design for live theatre, emphasizing conceptual and technical skill development.

 Lighting Design introduced students to the technical and creative foundations of theatrical lighting, from stage electrician skills to design principles. Through hands-on work and design tools like Vectorworks, they gained a comprehensive understanding of light's artistic and practical applications in theatre.

 The redesigned Acting for the Camera course included a technical track where students gained hands-on experience in film production, from equipment setup to video editing.
